

2020 Broomfield Art Guild Plein Air Painting Schedule

Due to the Safer at Home community guidelines for the Covid-19 Pandemic, we have made some changes to the BAG plein air schedule for this year. We will still meet on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month from approximately 9am - 12noon beginning May 21. However we have changed locations to be within the 10 mile travel limit as suggested by the State. We have also shortened the schedule to end in September. If we should go back to the Stay at Home requirements, plein air will be cancelled.

You do not have to sign up for this group - just show up! Be sure to bring your mask (and lunch if you would like) and practice social distancing guidelines. Beware that some locations may not have restrooms that are open. If weather is a problem it will be up to you to make a decision on whether to join the group. We will not be sending out cancellation notices.

May 21 - Anthem Community Park (Broomfield) 15663 Sheridan Pkwy, Broomfield, CO. Go north on Sheridan Blvd., continuing past 144th Ave. As you pass Lowell Blvd., take the second left turn which is marked Anthem Community Park. There are two ponds, great view of the front range, plenty of parking and restrooms.

June 4 - McKay Lake (Westminster) 144th Ave. Go north on Lowell Blvd. to 144th Ave. Turn right (east), drive past Zuni St. The parking lot will be on the right side of the street (it is between Zuni and Huron Sts.). There are lake views, a farm house, barn, and horses.

June 18 - Brunner House (Broomfield) The Brunner House is located at the northeast corner of Main Street and Midway Blvd. in Broomfield. The entrance is on Main St. just past Midway. Flowers should be in full bloom!

July 2 - Walnut Creek Lily Pond and Open Space (Westminster) 7577 W 103rd Ave. Take Sheridan south to 104th Ave. Turn right (west) and continue (crossing U.S. 36) to 103rd Ave. Turn right (north), then turn right at the Sensory Park sign. Park and follow the trail south to the lily pond.

July 16 - E.B. Rains Park (Northglenn) Go east on 120th Ave., as you cross over I-25, take the first right onto Grant St. continue to park entrance on the east side of the street. There is a pond, large trees, flowers and great view of the front range.

August 6 - Coal Creek Trailhead (Lafayette) Go north on Highway 287 to S. Boulder Rd. Turn right (east), turn right on Public Rd. (south). The trailhead parking is on the righthand side of the street. We usually paint along the creek near the trailhead.

****August 20 - Sunset Open Space** (Erie) Take Sheridan Blvd. (which turns into Sheridan Parkway) north crossing Highway 7 (King Soopers is at this intersection). Continue north turning left at County Rd. 4. Turn right onto County Rd. 5 continue on until you reach the open space on the west side of the road. There is a parking lot, picnic table, but no bathroom. We will meet at 6:30 to set up and begin (sunset is at 7:48). Come earlier if you'd like. 360 degree views of the front range.
