Fair warning: some of the locations do not have bathrooms or pavilions and will be a little bit of an adventure as they are not typical plein air locations. March 4, 2021 – E.B. Rains Park

11701 Community Center Dr, Northglenn, CO 80233

From I-25 and 120th Ave, go east on 120th Ave, turn right on Grant St, then the park is on the left.

March 18, 2021 – Brunner Farmhouse

R1055898, Broomfield, CO 80020

On the northeast corner of Midway Blvd and Main St., entrance is off Main St north of Midway.

April 1, 2021 – Rock Creek Trailhead

2190 S 104th St, Broomfield, CO 80020

From 287 and Dillon Rd, go west on Dillon Rd, turn left on 104th St, go past Northwest Pkwy, the park is a little parking lot on the left.

April 15, 2021 – Anthem Community Park

15663 Sheridan Pkwy, Broomfield, CO 80020

From Sheridan and Midway, go north on Sheridan, past Lowell Blvd, the park is on the left.

May 6, 2021 – Broomfield Commons Open Space, east side

Lowell Blvd, Broomfield, CO 80020

South of Paul Derda Rec Center, there is a parking lot for the walking trail on the west side of Lowell Blvd. It is across from the small strip mall with Code Ninjas and Outlaw Wings where the stop light is.

May 20, 2021 – Coal Creek Trailhead

South Public Road, Lafayette, CO 80026

From 287 and Northwest Pkwy, go north on 287, turn right on South Public Rd, go around the round-about to stay on South Public Rd, the trailhead parking is on the left.

June 3, 2021 – The Field Open Space (North Side)

555-341 E 10th Ave, Broomfield, CO 80020

From Main St. and Midway, go north on Main St, turn right on 10th Ave, park along the road on the right.

June 17, 2021 – McKay Lake

2000 W 144th Ave, Broomfield, CO 80023

From Midway and Zuni, go north on Zuni, turn right on 144th Ave, the parking lot is on the right.

July 15, 2021 – Broomfield Library

3 Community Park Rd, Broomfield, CO 80020

From 120th Ave and Sheridan, go west on 120th, turn right on Lamar St, turn left on Community Park Rd.

August 5, 2021 – **Celestial Seasonings (Field Trip :D)

4600 Sleepytime Dr, Boulder, CO 80301

From Broomfield, take US-36 to Boulder. Exit on CO-157 N/Foothills Pkwy. Follow Foothills Pkwy, turn right on Jay Rd. Turn left on Spine Rd. Turn left on Sleepytime Dr. ****Closed due to COVID. If not open, a new location will be chosen.**

August 19, 2021 – Highland Park South (Behind BCC)

E 3rd Ave, Broomfield, CO 80020

From Midway Blvd and Sheridan, go west on Midway, turn left on Ash St, turn right on E. 3rd Ave. There is a small space to park for the trailhead.

September 2, 2021 – Walnut Creek Lily Pond and Open Space

7577 W 103rd Ave, Westminster, CO 80021

From Sheridan and 120th, go south on Sheridan, turn right on 104th Ave, go past US-36. Turn right on 103rd Ave, then turn right at the Sensory Park sign. Go to the end of the parking lot, near the Sensory Park. Follow the trail to the lily pond.

September 16, 2021 – Metzger Farm

12080 Lowell Blvd, Westminster, CO 80234

On the northeast corner of Lowell Blvd and 120th Ave. Parking is off the east side of Lowell.

October 7, 2021 – The Field Open Space (East Side)

E 7th Ave, Broomfield, CO 80020

From Midway Blvd and Sheridan, go west on Midway Blvd, turn right on Ash St., Turn left on E. 7th Ave. There is a small area to park in the neighborhood near the trailhead.

October 21, 2021 – Near Community College Open Space

Stratford Lakes Dr., Westminster, CO 80031

From 120th Ave and Sheridan, go south on Sheridan, turn left on 112th Ave, go past the community college and turn left on Stratford Lakes Dr., park on the road. There is a little park on the left with a pond and benches that looks out onto Community College Open Space.
